Why a TERM Seminar?

To a very large extent, we live in a biblically-illiterate society. Christians are finding that many people believe that God is a force, sin is only what you think it to be, and consequences are only in the here and now. In addition, most believers are not gifted teachers. Many do not know the Scriptures.

A TERM seminar teaches people who are not gifted teachers, how to reach people who know little or nothing about the Bible.

What will I learn?

Most evangelism is done "one-on-one" or in small group settings. Using such a setting, TERM participants are taught how to lead a Bible study using *By this Name*.^{*} Chapters 1 to 15 of this book are taught in their entirety, inclusive of background information, tips on how to teach, ideas to illustrate points, ways to stay on track, and how to defuse potential problems.

The seminar includes the use of a "ToolBox" filled with over seventy visual aids to help illustrate points.

The seminar models an approach to teaching that Christians can imitate successfully.
