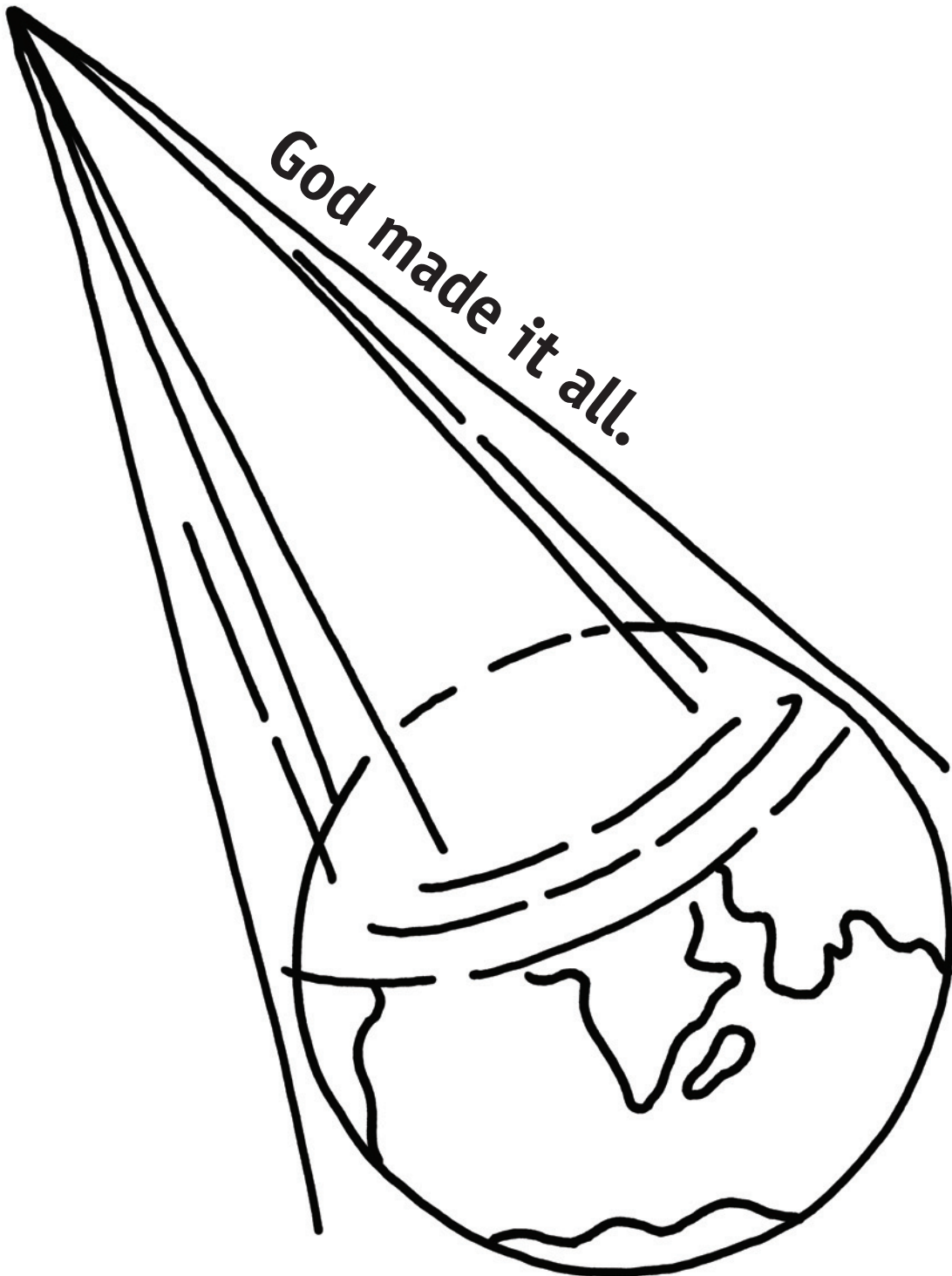

God is perfect.

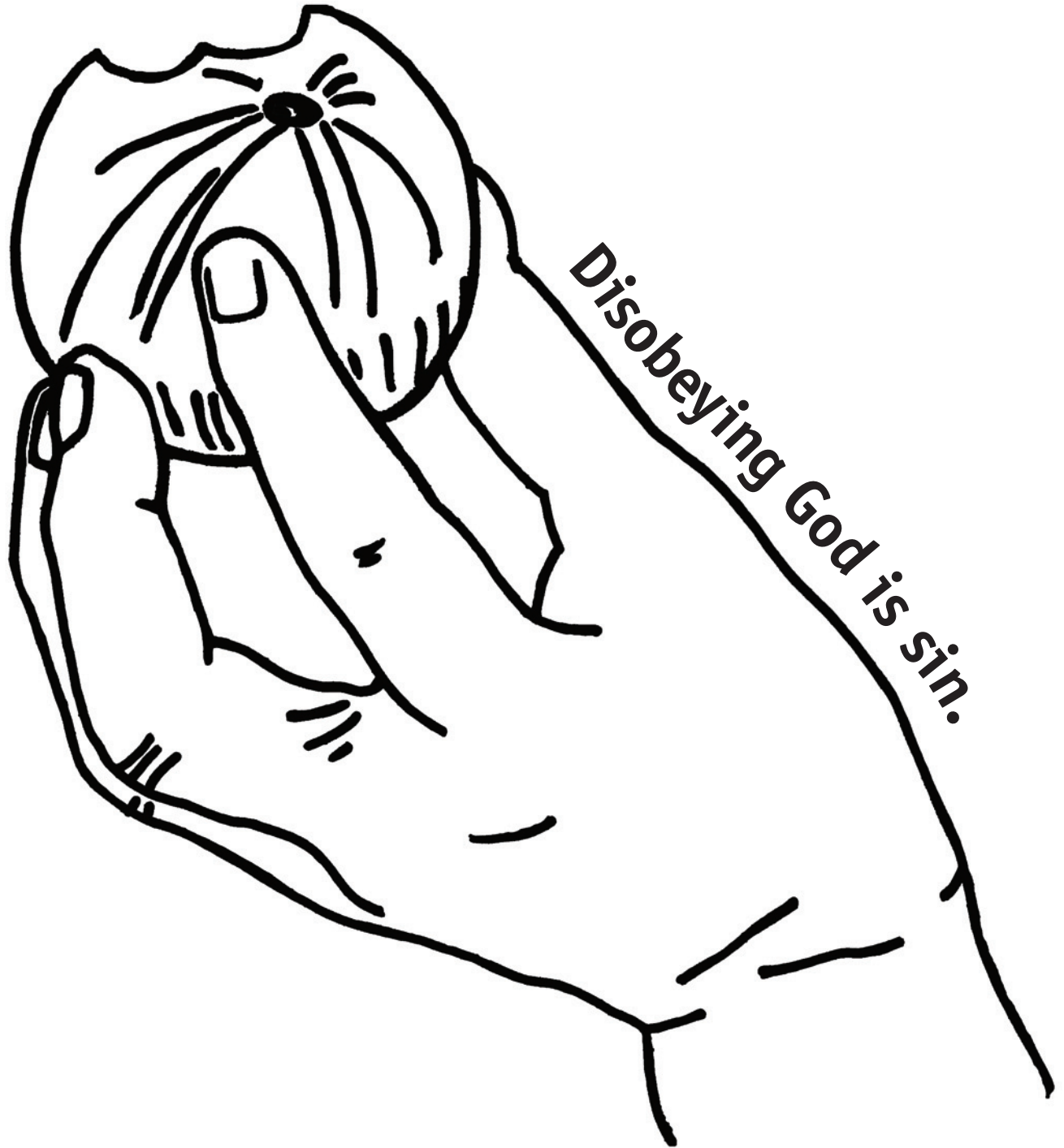


PERFECT:

SIN



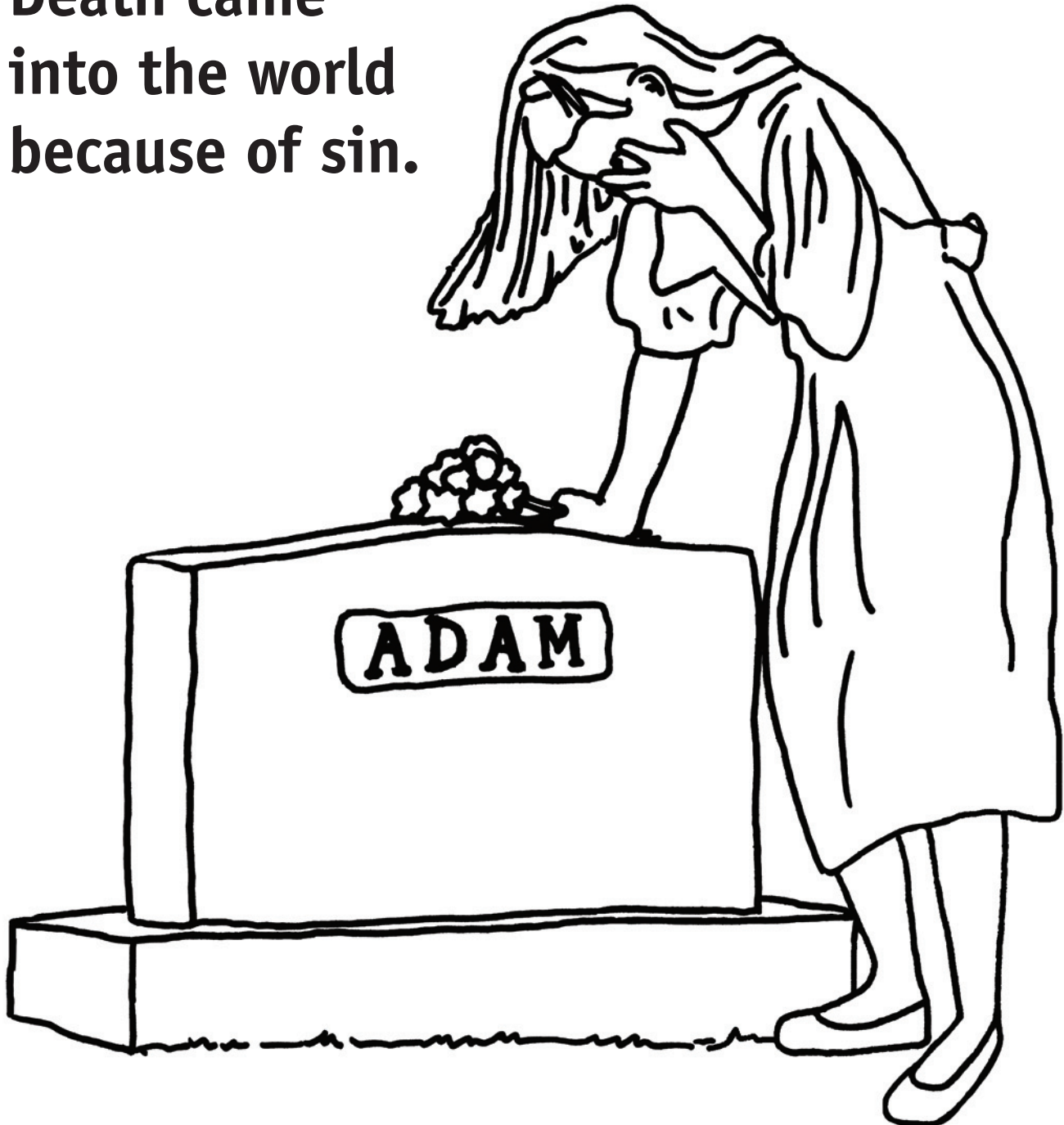
SIN:

TRUST



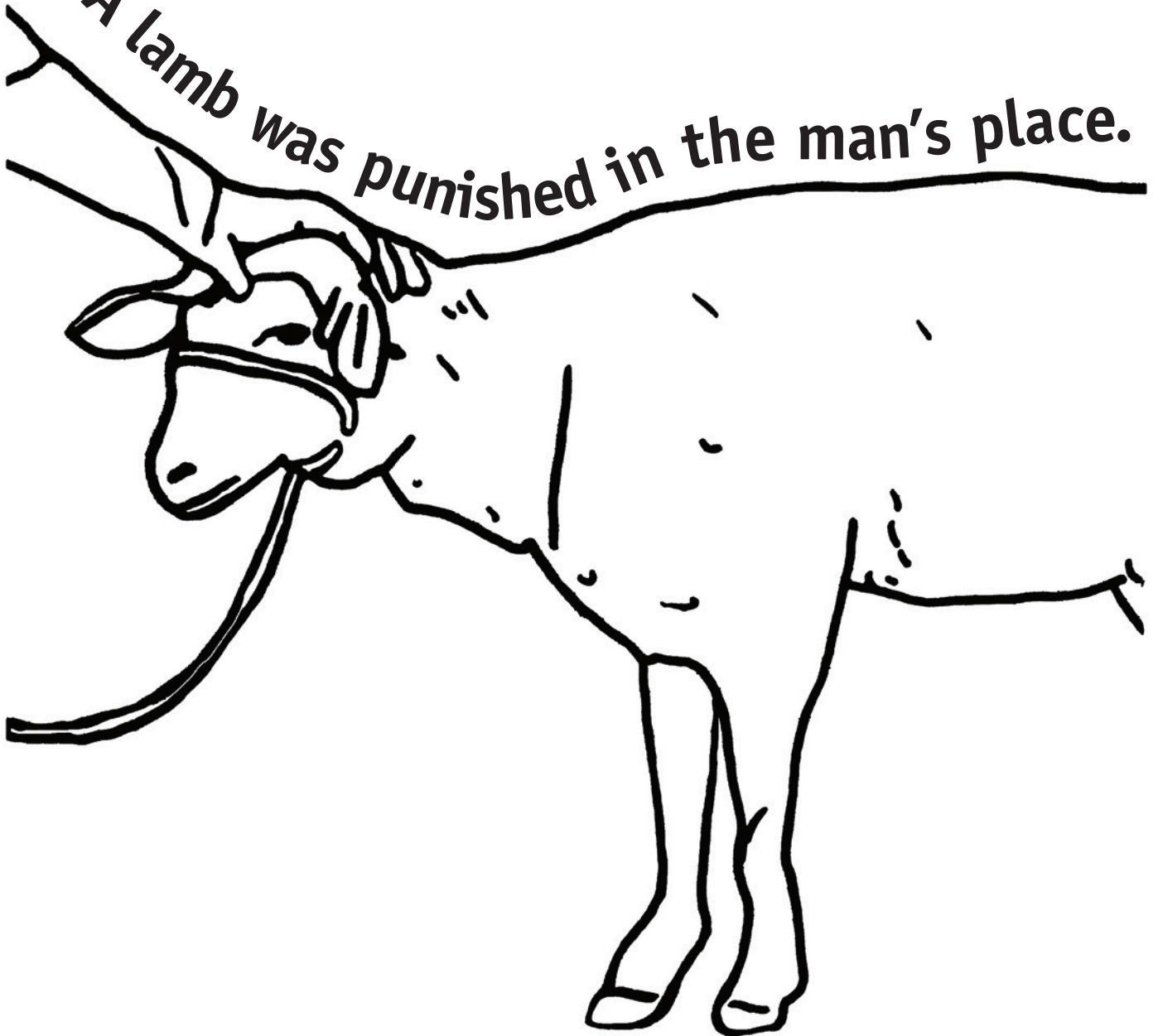
TRUST:

A lamb was punished in the man's place.

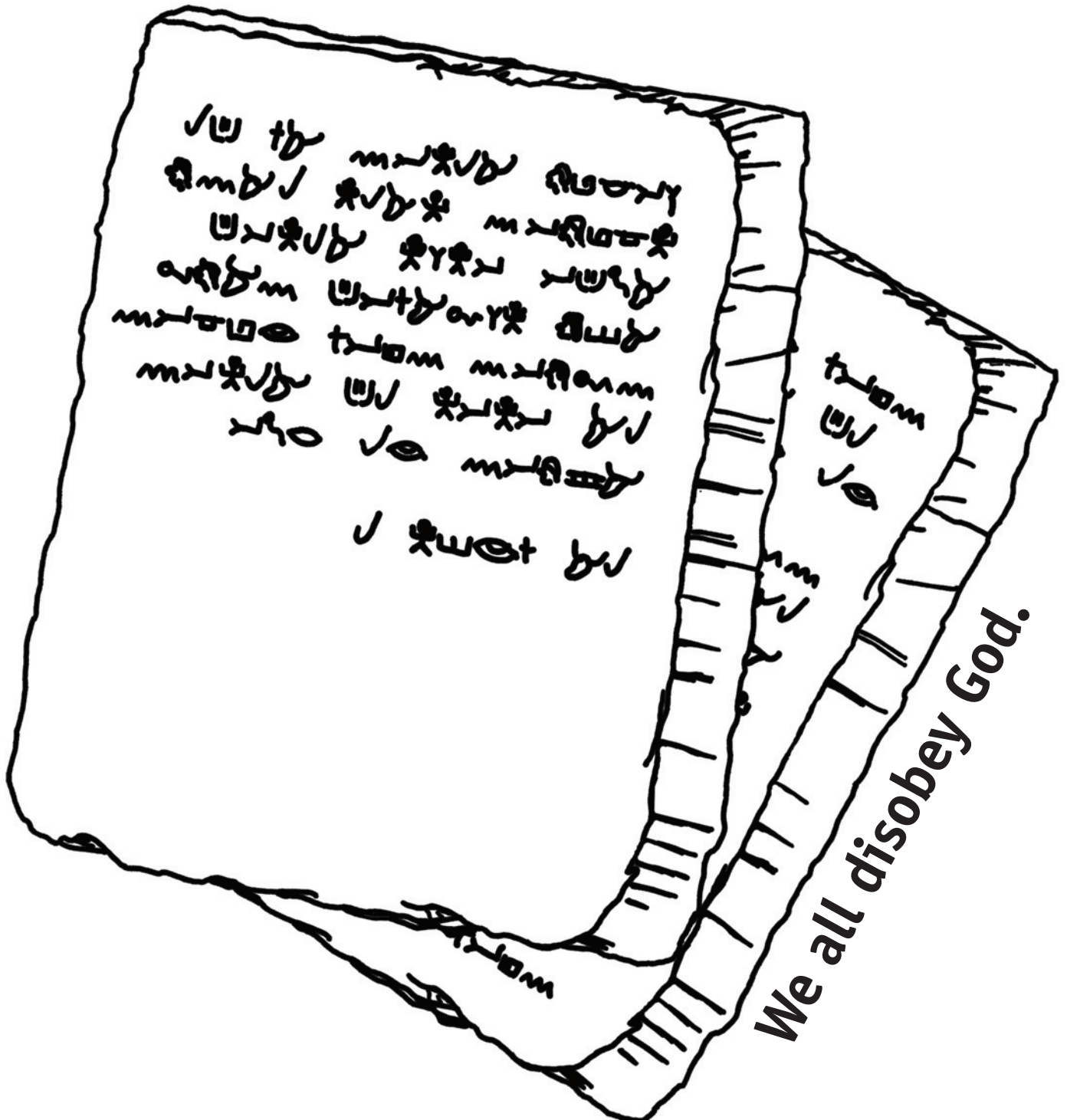


LAMB:

A lamb was punished in the man's place.

- The lamb was punished instead of the man.

SAVIOR



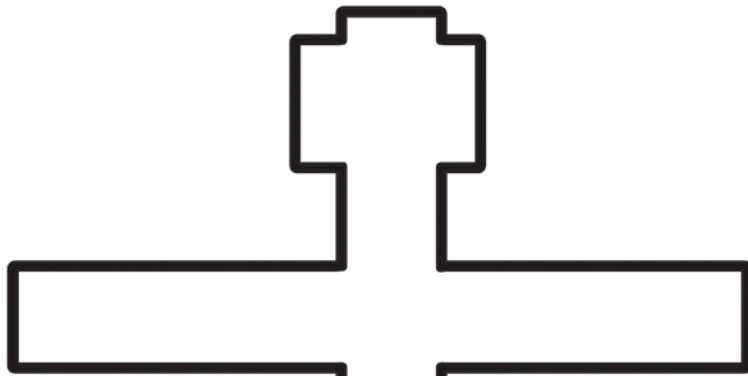
Jesus is the

SAVIOR:

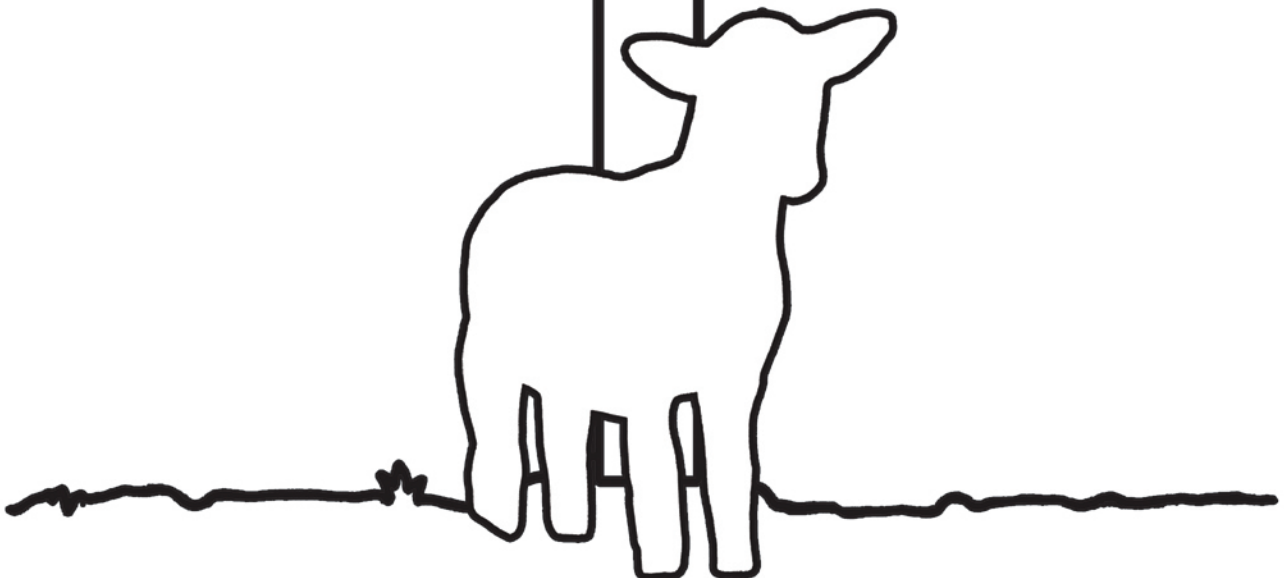
Jesus is the perfect Savior.

He is our lamb.**



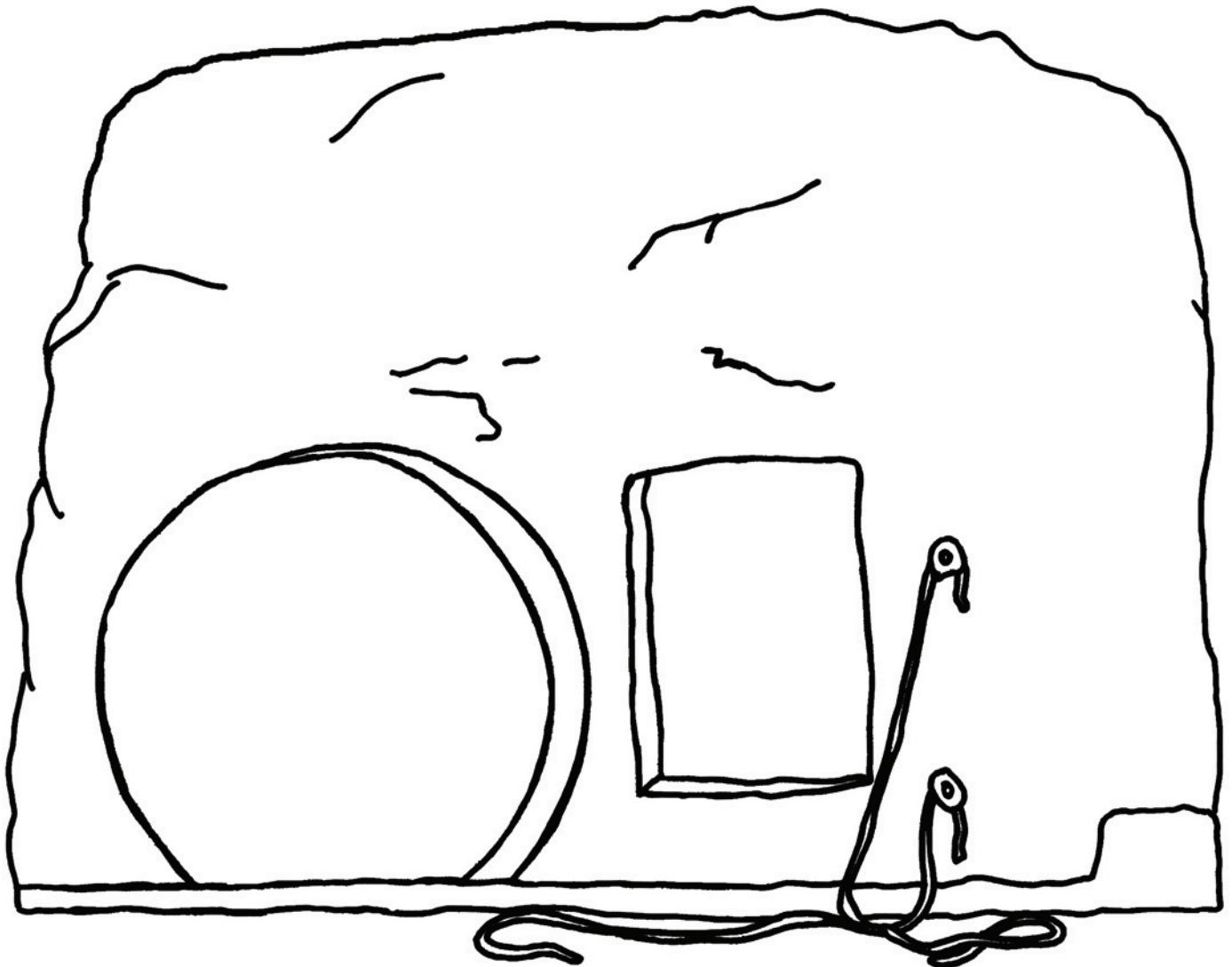
CROSS:

Jesus died in our place. He is our lamb.

- Jesus was perfect. He never sinned.
- Jesus had no sin to be punished.
- Jesus did not need to die.
- God's promise of a Savior was all about the lamb.
- Jesus was
 - (1) called the Lamb of God.
 - (2) a male.
 - (3) perfect.
- Jesus was brought to a special place of death: a cross.
- Just like the man bringing the lamb put his hand on its head and his sin was placed on the lamb, when Jesus was nailed to the cross, our sin was taken off of us and placed on him.
- Because all our sin was placed on Jesus, he had to be punished.
he had to die.
- Jesus is our Lamb. Jesus died instead of me.
- Jesus was the final lamb. No more lambs are needed.
- God kept His promise of a Savior.

Jesus came back to life. If we trust Him we can live forever with him.



ALIVE:

Jesus came back to life. If we trust Him we can live forever with him.

- Our sin put Jesus to death.
- After Jesus died, he was placed in a tomb.
- Nothing could stop God's plan:
 - (1) not death,
 - (2) not soldiers, and
 - (3) not a big stone.
- After three days, Jesus came back to life!
- No one had ever died and brought himself back to life.
- Jesus was stronger than death.
- People didn't need to be afraid of dying and going to live in Satan's terrible home.
 - Jesus could bring people back to life in Heaven, God's perfect home.
 - All you need to do is believe that Jesus is your Lamb—that he was punished for your sin. If you trust him, believing that what he said was true, when you finish living here on earth, Jesus will make you perfect so that you can live with him in Heaven.
- It is just that simple.
- Jesus met with his friends for 40 days. He ate, talked and traveled with them.
- Then Jesus returned to Heaven and he lives there now.
